

Devon County Council (Dartmoor National Park Off-Street Parking Places) Order

Devon County Council propose to make this under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to introduce a Traffic Regulation Order to manage the existing Dartmoor National Park Authority Car Parks.

If made the order would formalise the pay & display with revised charges at the car parks listed below:

Brentor Car Park, Haytor Lower Car Park and Haytor Middle Car Park for vehicle classes A, A1, B, B1, D1, L, P (as defined in the proposed order) with charges payable Mon-Sun 10am-6pm no vehicle may return within 1 hour: motorcycles free when parked, disabled persons vehicle all day £2, minibuses all day £5, and all other vehicles up to 3 hours £2, over 3 hours £3

Haytor Coach Park for vehicle classes, D, D1 (as defined in the proposed order) with charges payable Mon-Sun 10am-6pm no vehicle may return within 1 hour: minibuses all day £5 and coaches all day £5

Haytor Upper Car Park, Lydford Car Park, Meldon Reservoir Car Park, Postbridge Car Park and Princetown Car Park for vehicle classes A, A1, B, B1, D, D1, L, P (as defined in the proposed order) with charges payable Mon-Sun 10am-6pm no vehicle may return within 1 hour: motorcycles free when parked, disabled persons vehicle all day £2, minibuses all day £5, coaches all day £5 and all other vehicles up to 3 hours £2, over 3 hours £3.
